- Staff Liaisons 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Level Team (O'Connor, Howe, Clausen) Colleen O'Conner presented that 2<sup>nd</sup> graders were learning forces in motion and life cycle, using the scientific method. Students are learning to read nonfiction text to remember tomorrow, next week and next month. Reading strategies include, read a few pages, stop and think about what was read, then turn and talk. Students remember the text because they are lingering on what they are reading. Students are working on triple digit addition and subtraction and persuasive writing.
- Staff Liaison 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Level Team (Rudko, Barnhart, Barstow) Jen Rudko presented that the 5<sup>th</sup> grade class is working on a legacy project for Arrowhead and are looking forward to sailing, science a float marine science field trip, and end of the year party. Scott Barstow presented that his class is working on a business expedition unit, exploring entrepreneurship, hands on models, prototypes and a shark tank presentation. Debbie Barnhart presented that as a class, they are reading Roll of Thunder, Hear my Cry, discussing race relations in America during the Great Depression. This class has been bound together by their need to heal and has received on outpouring of support from NSD and Arrowhead families.
- Principal, Kristin Bailey presented that Arrowhead classes have participated in more than 60 off campus events; including, pumpkin patches, Hibulb cultural center, UW Arboretum, Issaquah Salmon Hatchery and live theatre performances.
